Bulletin Board Policy

The Wabash Carnegie Public Library's Bulletin Board serves as a medium of communication for the library and community it serves. It is to promote community information and community awareness.

While first considerations are given to the needs of the Wabash Carnegie Public Library notices of civic, cultural, and or educational events, or approved by library administration may be accepted for display as room permits. However, the library reserves the right to determine what shall be accepted for display. Political advertisements or notices of recruitment to a particular group or club shall not be accepted for display. Library has right to take down any notices or displays posted that it has not authorized immediately.

All notices and displays are posted at the risk of the person or group, and the library bears no responsibility for the content, for damage to notices, or for their unauthorized removal from the display areas. Notices and displays can be limited to 3 months for posting unless otherwise authorized by library administration.

Containers for contributions may not be placed in the Library.

Questions concerning the posting of any specific notice, poster, or other material should be referred to the Information Services Manager, who may consult with the Executive Director when needed.
